HEALTHCARE FACILITY

- Auckland City Hospital: 4 patients: 2 with EMRSA-15 strain, including 1 who is a resident of an Auckland healthcare facility †; 1 with AKh4 MRSA.
- Middlemore Hospital: 4 patients: 1 with AKh4 MRSA; 1 with EMRSA-15 strain; 1 with WR/AK1 strain.
- Starship Children's Health, Auckland: 3 patients: 1 with AKh4 MRSA, who is from Samoa; 1 with WR/AK1 strain; 1 outpatient clinic patient.
- Mission Bay Rest Home, Auckland: 1 patient.
- Auckland healthcare facilities †: 4 patients: 2 with EMRSA-15 strain; 1 with EMRSA-16 strain; 1 with WR/AK1 strain.
- North Shore Hospital: 3 patients: 1 with AKh4 MRSA; 1 emergency department patient with EMRSA-15 strain; 1 with WR/AK1 strain.
- Waitakere Hospital: 1 patient with EMRSA-15 strain.
- Waikato Hospital: 3 patients: 2 in Ward 26, Orthopaedics, with EMRSA-15 strain; 1 emergency department patient with WR/AK1 strain.
- Tauranga Hospital: 1 patient with EMRSA-15 strain.
- Whakatane Hospital: 1 patient with EMRSA-15 strain.
- Hawkes Bay Hospital: 1 patient with EMRSA-15 strain, who is a resident of a Hawkes Bay healthcare facility †.
- Wellington Hospital: 1 patient with EMRSA-15 strain.
- Christchurch Hospital: 1 staff from Australia, with AKh4 MRSA isolated during pre-employment screening.
- Leslie Groves Hospital, Dunedin: 1 patient with EMRSA-15 strain.

HEALTHCARE FACILITY (but patient in isolation from time of admission)

- Auckland City Hospital: 1 patient.
- North Shore Hospital: 1 patient, post-discharge from an Australian hospital.

COMMUNITY

- Auckland: 2 people: 1 with EMRSA-15 strain; 1 with WR/AK1 strain.
- Waikato: 1 healthcare worker with EMRSA-15 strain.
- Wellington: 1 person from the United Kingdom, with EMRSA-15 strain.
- Otago: 2 people: 1 with EMRSA-15 strain.

CURRENT OUTBREAKS OF NON-MULTIRESISTANT MRSA

Non-multiresistant EMRSA-15 (ciprofloxacin-resistant, erythromycin-susceptible) were newly isolated from 1 patient in Whangarei Hospital; 3 patients in Middlemore Hospital; 1 patient in Rotorua Hospital, post-discharge from Waikato Hospital; 1 patient in a Hawkes Bay healthcare facility †; and 1 Wanganui community patient.
