HEALTHCARE FACILITY

Auckland City Hospital: 2 patients: 1 with EMRSA-15 strain, who is a resident of an Auckland healthcare

facility †;

1 outpatient clinic patient who is a resident of Goodwood Park Trust,

Auckland.

Middlemore Hospital: 1 patient with EMRSA-15 strain.

Auckland healthcare facilities †: 3 patients: 1 with AKh4 MRSA;

1 with EMRSA-15 strain.

Waikato Hospital: 2 patients with EMRSA-15 strain, including 1 patient in Ward 7, Burns, and 1 patient in Ward 12,

Surgical, who is post-discharge from Taumaranui Hospital.

Hamilton healthcare facilities †: 1 patient with EMRSA-15 strain, post-discharge from Waikato Hospital.

HEALTHCARE FACILITY (but patient in isolation from time of admission)

Taranaki Base Hospital: 1 patient with EMRSA-15 strain.

COMMUNITY

Northland: 1 person with WR/AK1 strain.

Auckland: 7 people: 2 with EMRSA-15 strain, including 1 pre-employment screen of a healthcare

worker from the United Kingdom;

2 with WR/AK1 strain;

1 with multiresistant WSPP1 MRSA;

1 pre-employment screen of a healthcare worker.

Waikato: 1 person with WR/AK1 strain.

CURRENT OUTBREAKS OF NON-MULTIRESISTANT MRSA

Non-multiresistant EMRSA-15 (ciprofloxacin-resistant, erythromycin-susceptible) were newly isolated from 1 staff, from the United Kingdom, in Whangarei Hospital; 1 patient in Middlemore Hospital; 1 patient in an Auckland healthcare facility †; and 1 Christchurch Women's Hospital outpatient clinic patient.
