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## MULTIRESISTANT MRSA NEWLY CONFIRMED: 25 September -1 October 2004

### HEALTHCARE FACILITY

- Oakhaven Hospital, Whangarei: 1 patient with AKh4 MRSA.
- Auckland City Hospital: 6 patients: 3 with EMRSA-15 strain, including 1 outpatient clinic patient;  
1 with AKh4 MRSA.
- Middlemore Hospital: 3 patients with EMRSA-15 strain.  
3 staff with EMRSA-15 strain.
- North Shore Hospital: 1 staff with EMRSA-15 strain.
- Starship Children's Health, Auckland: 1 patient with EMRSA-15 strain.
- Lexham Gardens, Auckland: 1 patient with EMRSA-15 strain.
- Auckland healthcare facilities †: 3 patients with EMRSA-15 strain.
- Waikato Hospital: 2 patients in Ward 2, Surgical, with AKh4 MRSA.
- Hamilton healthcare facilities †: 1 patient with EMRSA-15 strain, transferred from Thames Hospital.
- Rotorua Hospital: 1 patient with EMRSA-15 strain, who is a resident of a Rotorua healthcare facility †.
- Palmerston North Hospital: 1 patient with WR/AK1 strain.

### HEALTHCARE FACILITY (but patient in isolation from time of admission)

- Waikato Hospital: 1 patient with EMRSA-15 strain.

### COMMUNITY

- Auckland: 7 people: 6 with EMRSA-15 strain.

## CURRENT OUTBREAKS OF NON-MULTIRESISTANT MRSA

Non-multiresistant EMRSA-15 (ciprofloxacin-resistant, erythromycin-susceptible) were newly isolated from 2 patients in Middlemore Hospital; and 2 Auckland community patients.
