HEALTHCARE FACILITY

- Auckland City Hospital: 9 patients with EMRSA-15 strain, including 3 in Rangitoto, Elderly Services Ward, 2 who are residents of Auckland healthcare facilities †, and 1 outpatient clinic (Green Lane site) patient.
- Middlemore Hospital: 5 patients with EMRSA-15 strain.
- Auckland healthcare facilities †: 3 patients with EMRSA-15 strain.
- Waikato Hospital: 4 patients: 3 with EMRSA-15 strain, including 2 in Ward 14, Surgical; 1 with AKh4 MRSA, post-discharge from Taumaranui Hospital.
- Hamilton healthcare facilities †: 2 patients with EMRSA-15 strain.
- Rotorua Hospital: 1 emergency department patient with EMRSA-15 strain.
- Golden Pond Home & Hospital, Whakatane: 1 patient with EMRSA-15 strain.
- Taranaki Base Hospital: 1 patient with AKh4 MRSA.
- Hawkes Bay Hospital: 1 patient with EMRSA-16 strain.
- Christchurch Hospital: 1 patient with WR/AK1 strain.

HEALTHCARE FACILITY (but patient in isolation from time of admission)

- Arohanui Hospice, Palmerston North: 1 patient, transferred from an Australian hospital, with AKh4 MRSA, who is an outpatient clinic patient at Palmerston North Hospital.
- Christchurch Hospital: 1 patient with AKh4 MRSA, who is post-discharge from an Australian hospital.

COMMUNITY

- Northland: 2 people.
- Auckland: 10 people: 5 with EMRSA-15 strain; 2 with WR/AK1 strain.
- Waikato: 2 people: 1 with EMRSA-15 strain; 1 with WR/AK1 strain.
- Otago: 1 person.

CURRENT OUTBREAKS OF NON-MULTIRESISTANT MRSA

Non-multiresistant EMRSA-15 (ciprofloxacin-resistant, erythromycin-susceptible) were newly isolated from 1 staff at Auckland City Hospital; 1 patient in Middlemore Hospital; 1 patient in an Auckland healthcare facility †; 1 patient in Tokoroa Life Care, Tokoroa; 1 patient in isolation in Auckland City Hospital; and 1 Auckland community patient.
