MULTIRESISTANT MRSA NEWLY CONFIRMED: 11-17 December 2004

HEALTHCARE FACILITY

- Whangarei Hospital: 2 patients with WR/AK1 strain.
- Auckland City Hospital: 2 patients with AKh4 MRSA, including 1 resident of St John's Hospital, Auckland.
- Middlemore Hospital: 8 patients: 5 with EMRSA-15 strain, including 1 who also has non-multiresistant EMRSA-15; 1 in ICU with AKh4 MRSA; 1 with WR/AK1 strain.
- North Shore Hospital: 1 patient in Ward 8, Surgical, with AKh4 MRSA.
- Auckland healthcare facilities †: 1 patient with AKh4 MRSA.
- Hamilton healthcare facilities †: 1 patient with EMRSA-15 strain, post-discharge from Waikato Hospital.
- Tauranga Hospital: 1 patient with WR/AK1 strain.
- Hodgson House, Tauranga: 1 patient with EMRSA-15 strain.
- Rotorua Hospital: 1 outpatient clinic patient with WR/AK1 strain.
- Mary Shapley Health & Lifecare, Whakatane: 1 staff with EMRSA-15 strain.
- Wakefield Hospital, Wellington: 1 patient with EMRSA-15 strain.

HEALTHCARE FACILITY (but patient in isolation from time of admission)

- Middlemore Hospital: 1 patient with AKh4 MRSA.
- Starship Children's Health, Auckland: 1 patient with WR/AK1 strain.
- Christchurch Hospital: 1 patient, post-discharge from an Australian hospital.

COMMUNITY

- Auckland: 4 people: 2 with AKh4 MRSA; 1 with EMRSA-15 strain; 1 with WR/AK1 strain.
- Waikato: 2 people with EMRSA-15 strain, including 1 pre-employment screen of a healthcare worker and 1 patient who also has non-multiresistant EMRSA-15.

CURRENT OUTBREAKS OF NON-MULTIRESISTANT MRSA

Non-multiresistant EMRSA-15 (ciprofloxacin-resistant, erythromycin-susceptible) were newly isolated from 1 patient in Auckland City Hospital, who is a resident of an Auckland healthcare facility †; 1 staff at Middlemore Hospital; 1 patient in an Auckland healthcare facility †; 1 patient in Phoenix Rehabilitation Unit, Hamilton; 1 patient in Hawkes Bay Hospital; 1 patient in Glenwood Hospital, Masterton, post-discharge from Masterton Hospital and Wellington Hospital; 1 patient in Oamaru Hospital; 2 Auckland community patients; and 1 Tauranga community patient.
