### MULTIRESISTANT MRSA NEWLY CONFIRMED: 26 February-4 March 2005

#### HEALTHCARE FACILITY

Auckland City Hospital: 4 patients: 3 with EMRSA-15 strain, one of whom is post-discharge and another

who is a resident of Masonic Village RCF.

Middlemore Hospital: 7 patients: 6 with EMRSA-15 strain;

1 with AKh4 MRSA.

1 staff with EMRSA-15 strain.

North Shore Hospital: 2 patients: 1 with AKh4 MRSA in Ward 8, Surgical;

1 with EMRSA-15 strain.

Auckland healthcare facilities †: 6 patients: 4 with EMRSA-15 strain;

1 with AKh4 MRSA; 1 with WR/AK1 strain.

Mary Shapley Health & Lifecare, Whakatane: 1 patient with EMRSA-15 strain.

Rotorua Hospital: 1 staff with EMRSA-15 strain.

Hawkes Bay Hospital: 1 emergency department patient with WR/AK1 strain.

Wellington Hospital: 1 patient with EMRSA-15 strain.

1 staff with EMRSA-15 strain.

#### CURRENT OUTBREAKS OF NON-MULTIRESISTANT MRSA

Non-multiresistant EMRSA-15 (ciprofloxacin-resistant, erythromycin-susceptible) were newly isolated from 1 patient in Auckland City Hospital; 1 patient in Middlemore Hospital; 1 patient in an Auckland healthcare facility †; 1 patient in Tauranga Hospital; 1 patient in Glenbrae Home and Hospital, Tauranga; 1 patient in isolation in Rotorua Hospital; 1 day surgery patient in Hawkes Bay Hospital; 1 patient in Wakefield Hospital, Wellington; 2 Auckland community patients; 1 Hutt community patient; 1 Wellington nursing student; and a pre-employment screen of a healthcare worker from the United Kingdom.
