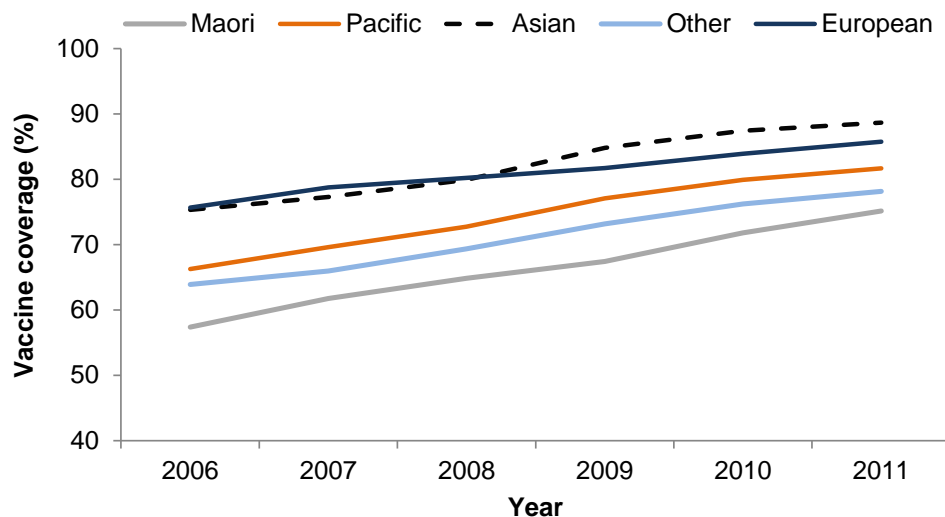


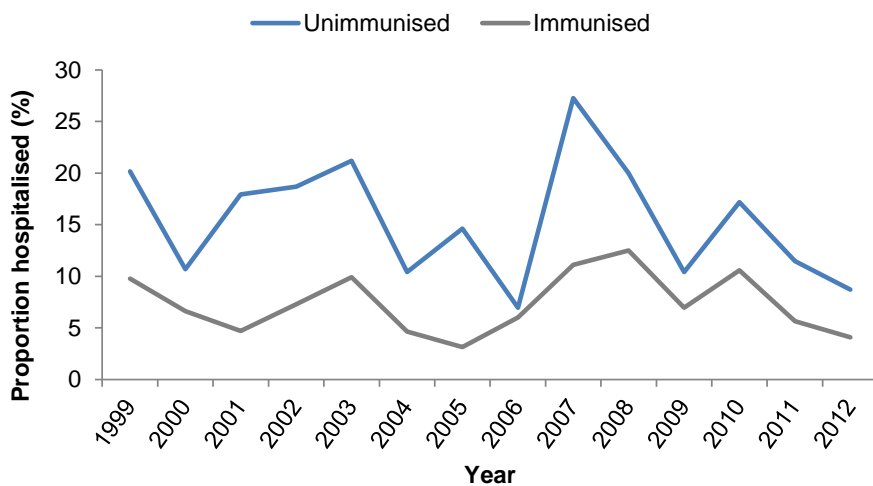

Pertussis in New Zealand: morbidity and immunisation

Case definition

A confirmed case was defined as:

A person who attended the camp between 21 and 23 March 2012 and who tested positive for *Campylobacter*.

OR

A person who resides in the same household as a confirmed case above and who tested positive for *Campylobacter* between 21 March and 12 April 2012.

A clinical case was defined as:

A person who attended the camp between 21 March and 23 March 2012 and who developed one of the following symptoms before 2 April 2012.

OR

A person who resides in the same household as a clinical case above and who developed one of the following symptoms between 21 March and 12 April 2012 [two incubation periods].
