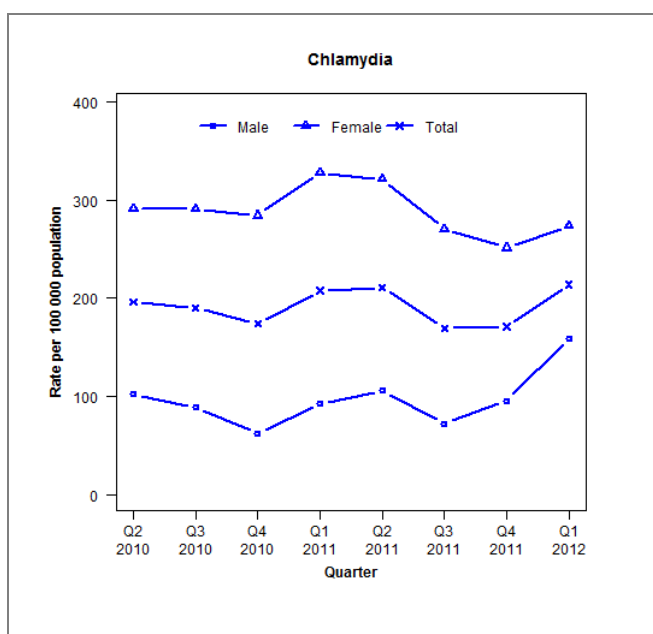


Laboratory surveillance of chlamydia and gonorrhoea: January-March 2012
