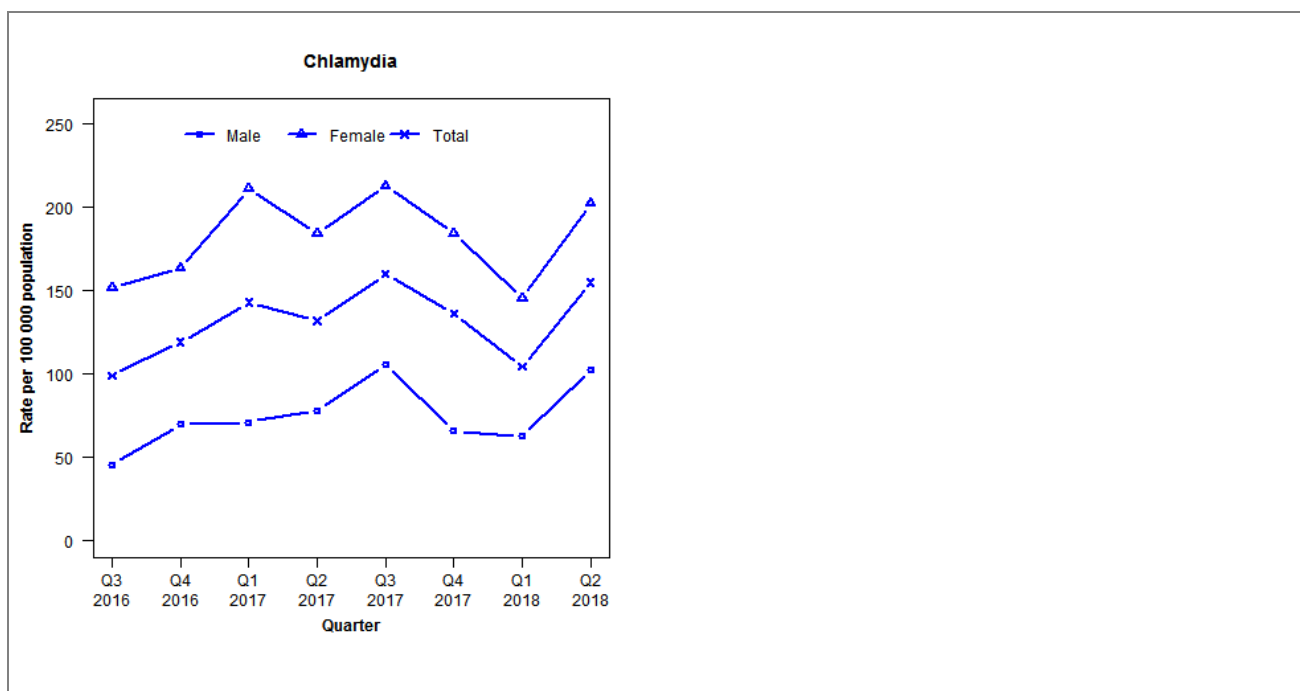


## Laboratory surveillance of chlamydia and gonorrhoea: April - June 2018

Quarterly chlamydia and gonorrhoea rates (male, female and total<sup>1</sup> population), July 2016 to June 2018

Note: Data processing methods allow for exclusion of repeat tests. Gonorrhoea rates are not presented as there are fewer than five cases in many quarters. From 19 January 2017 NAAT testing was introduced for all gonorrhoea specimens in one of the two laboratories.
